


# **Bicyclists: Wear A Helmet!**

## **Certificate of Eligibility Now Available Via Email**

As of March 17<sup>th</sup>, foreign nationals can receive their Certificate of Eligibility via email. Additionally, foreign nationals can apply for visas and landing permits by presenting the email at a Japanese embassy, consulate, or consular office. This will reduce time, effort, and costs.
