

Recipe Corner

Mohingar

Mohingar (မုန်ဟင်းခါး) is a popular noodle and fish soup from Myanmar. This recipe was provided by Ms. Hsu Myat Win, a Niigata resident from Palaw, Myanmar. Enjoy this warm, comforting dish!



Ingredient	Amount	Ingredient	Amount	Toppings
Somen noodles	200 g (4 bundles)	Vegetable oil	1 Tbsp	Boiled eggs (2)
Catfish (or mackerel)	400 g (sliced)	Nam pla (fish sauce)	2 Tbsp	Cilantro
Onion	2	Water (for soup)	1,200 cc	Lemon
Garlic	2 cloves	Turmeric	1 tsp	Chili pepper
Lemongrass (dried)	2 stalks	Chili pepper	1 tsp	
Ajinomoto	1 tsp	Salt	2 tsp	
Roasted soybean powder (kinako)	4 Tbsp	Pepper	1 tsp	
Rice flour	2 Tbsp	Sugar	2 tsp	

Instructions:

1. Place the catfish (or mackerel) in a pot with enough water to submerge it (water not included in recipe above). Add lemongrass (1 stalk) and turmeric, cover with a lid, and simmer for 5 minutes at low heat. Remove the fish, cool, then slice into thin pieces (remove the skin and bones if there are any).

2. Mince the onion (1), lemon grass (1 stalk) and garlic. Slice the remaining onion. Cut the boiled eggs in half vertically. 3. Add vegetable oil to the pot, as well as the minced vegetables, chili pepper, and nam pla. Then, add the sliced fish and pepper, and stir well. Gradually add water and increase the flame to medium heat. After the water comes to a boil, add the sliced onions, ajinomoto, sugar, and salt. Add the roasted soybean flour and rice flour after first mixing with a small amount of water so that there are no clumps. Cover with a lid and simmer for 20 minutes at medium heat.

4. In a separate pot, boil water and add the somen noodles. Boil. Rinse under running water and then remove the excess water.

5. Transfer the noodles to a serving bowl. Pour in the soup and add the toppings (boiled eggs, cilantro, chili pepper, etc.) as desired.
